The Comprehensive Career Boat Building Program is physically demanding and requires all applicants to:

- Repeatedly lift items of up to 50lbs throughout the day
- Work with their arms above their head for long periods of time
- Kneel and walk for long periods of time on cement services
- Stand roughly 6 hours a day
- Bend/stoop, squat/crouch, climb, and twist throughout the day
- Be able to climb up and down ladders repeatedly
- Work and move around, under, inside, and outside of boats
- Work around moving equipment
- Work in tight/small spaces
- Work among and with very noisy machines and power tools
- Work among dust particles and wear appropriate safety gear
- Operate hand and power tools for long periods of time
- And to work in close proximity to fellow classmates and Faculty
